

## PROPOSED RULE COST/BENEFIT ANALYSIS

### **STATEMENT OF ECONOMIC IMPACT:**

Fees associated with this rule are outlined in Section 500. General Fees and Charges for inspection, certificates, and permits are set forth in Section 500 of the "Phytosanitary and Post-Entry Certification Rules." IDAPA 02.06.04.500. These are standard fees that apply to a number of similar functions in the agency.

Special Permits for importation of hops from areas under quarantine will be assessed a fee of sixty dollar (\$60) per permit.
