Discussion took place related to Section 104 of the current rule.

Dr. Barton suggested rewording the second and third sentence to read as follows: "All dairy type goats, including bucks six months of age or older, shall have been tested negative for *Brucella melitensis* within thirty (30) days of the date of entry into the state of Idaho. The negative test chart shall be signed by the person in charge of the laboratory where the test was made, approved by the state animal health official of the state of origin and attached to the certificate of veterinarian inspection."

Mr. Boyd directed the group to proposed Section 701, Goat Assessments. No changes were made as a result of the discussion.
