

The Western States Livestock Health Association has issued recommendations to harmonize Trichomoniasis regulations for all western states. On May 20, 2015, Idaho Trichomoniasis Task Force approved the recommendations and is willing to cooperate with the harmonization effort.

Provide a short summary of the changes this rule makes:

IDAPA 02.04.29.200.03 – Acceptable tests will include culture or polymerase chain reaction (PCR).
IDAPA 02.04.29.210.01.a-c – The validity of a Trichomoniasis test will be extended from 30 days to 60 days.
IDAPA 02.04.29.210.02 - The accepted age for virgin bulls imported into Idaho will be changed from 12 months to 18 months.
IDAPA 02.04.29.310.04 – Acceptable tests will include culture or PCR.
IDAPA 02.04.29.331.01-02 – Remove the 48 hour sample submission deadline.
IDAPA 02.04.29.400.07 - Acceptable tests will include culture or PCR.
IDAPA 02.04.29.410.02 - Acceptable tests will include culture or PCR.
