

The rule is being amended to allow the Administrator greater latitude in considering producer requests for change of ownership tuberculosis testing exemptions.

IDAPA 02.04.19.450.01 The petitioner is requesting the rule change so that the Administrator may grant change of ownership tuberculosis testing exemptions for domestic cervidae on a case-by-case basis, based upon individual circumstances.
