Dear Licensee:

Effective July 1, 2009, the Dealers in Farm Produce Act (Title 22, Chapter 13, Idaho Code) will be repealed. After that time, the Idaho State Department of Agriculture will no longer license nor otherwise regulate dealers in farm produce.

As you know, licenses for dealers in farm produce expire, pursuant to statute, on May 30 of each year. In order to avoid the difficult position of dealers being unlicensed for the month between May 30 and July 1, 2009, ISDA will extend licenses currently in effect through June 30, 2009. However, in order to extend your license, ISDA must receive proof that your bond or other form of financial assurance will remain effective through June 30, 2009. ISDA must receive that documentation no later than May 15, 2009.

If your bond or other form of financial assurance will not be in effect through June 30, 2009, please inform ISDA of that fact. Your license will then expire May 30, 2009, and you will be unlicensed for the month of June 2009.
