It is unlawful to use this product on Alfalfa grown for seed after July 31, 2016.

Follow all applicable directions, restrictions, Worker Protection Standard requirements, and precautions on the EPA-registered label.

This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of application.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ALFALFA GROWN FOR SEED

For control of Spotted alfalfa aphids and Lygus bugs, apply a maximum of 1.33 quarts of this product per acre when insects first appear in a minimum of 25 gallons of water per acre using ground boom equipment only. Do not apply by air.

RESTRICTIONS /PRECAUTIONS

- Do not apply more than 1.33 quarts of this product (1 lb. a.i.) per acre per season.
- Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.
- Do not make more than 2 applications per season.
- Do not apply within 21 days of harvest.
- Restricted Entry Interval (REI) is 7 days.
- Do not apply within 100 feet of rivers, natural ponds, lakes, streams, reservoirs, marshes, estuaries, and commercial fish ponds.

RESTRICTIONS / PRECAUTIONS *(continuation)*

- A 30 foot vegetative buffer strip must be maintained between all treated areas with this product and rivers, natural ponds, lakes, streams, reservoirs, marshes, estuaries, and commercial fish ponds.
- Do not graze treated Alfalfa fields or feed treated forage, crop residue or seed millings, as required by the Idaho Rules Governing Pesticide Use and Application, IDAPA 02-03-03-800.
- Do not cut treated Alfalfa for hay or forage.
- If the applicator of this pesticide is not the crop producer, the applicator should provide a copy of this labeling to the producer of the crop. Producers of this crop who use this product or cause the product to be used on a field they operate, should provide a copy of this pesticide label to the seed conditioner.
- All seed from seed Alfalfa treated with this product is to be tagged at the conditioning plant "Not for Human or Animal Consumption". It shall be the grower's responsibility to notify the conditioning plant of any Alfalfa seed crop treated with this product.
- Seed from seed Alfalfa treated with this product is not to be used for sprouting.
- All Alfalfa seed screenings shall be disposed of in such a way that they cannot be distributed or used for human food or animal feed.
- No portion of the Alfalfa seed plant, including but not limited to green chop, hay, pellets, meal whole seed, cracked seed, roots, bulbs, leaves and seed screenings may be used or distributed for food or feed purposes.
- This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment of residues on blooming crops or broadleaved weeds. Do not apply 1.33 quarts (1 lb. a.i.) per acre to blooming seed Alfalfa; apply at that rate as a prebloom or postbloom spray only. Application of 0.6 quart (1.33 pints) per acre (0.5 lb. a.i./A) to blooming seed Alfalfa must be timed to coincide with periods of minimum activity, between late evening and midnight.
- This product is extremely toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates and toxic to birds and mammals and should not be used where impact on listed threatened or endangered species is likely. Contact the US Fish and Wildlife Service for information on listed threatened or endangered species. Consult the EPA-registered label for additional restrictions and precautions to protect aquatic organisms.
