Bovine Tuberculosis is a contagious bacterial disease affecting cattle, caused by *Mycobacterium bovis*. Bovine Tuberculosis may be transmitted to people through contact with infected cattle. Bovine Tuberculosis has been diagnosed in several states throughout the United States.


Therefore, by authority of Title 25, Chapter 2, Idaho Code and IDAPA 02.04.21.111, this Order is issued the 27 day of June, 2007, and is effective the 1st day of July, 2007, in order to prevent the introduction and dissemination of Bovine Tuberculosis among the cattle of Idaho. The following import restrictions are placed on cattle entering Idaho:

All cattle used for rodeo or timed events must have a negative bovine tuberculosis test within the last twelve (12) months prior to importation into Idaho.

This requirement is in addition to other tuberculosis testing requirements of record found in IDAPA 02.04.21, "Rules Governing Importation of Animals."

The only exceptions to this Order shall be by written approval of the Administrator of the Division of Animal Industries upon epidemiological evaluation and risk determination.
