For control of wireworms and cutworms (surface and subterranean), apply 51-102 fl. oz./A. Apply just before planting and immediately incorporate into the top 4-8 inches of soil. Apply by ground in a minimum of 10 gallons of water per acre. Do not apply by air.

REI 3 DAYS

- This product may only be applied using ground equipment.
- Foliar application of this product to potatoes is prohibited.
- Do not use on commercially grown potatoes which will be hand-harvested.
- Do not apply within 35 days of harvest.
