Apply the following rate by ground or by air in a minimum of 5 gallons of water per acre.

Peas (Succulent)	1/2 pint	5 days
	1/2 - 1 pint	14 days
Peas (Dry)	1/2 - 1 pint	14 days

#### Restrictions:

- Do not enter or allow worker entry during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 48 hours.
- Do not exceed a total of 0.5 lb. active ingredient Dimethoate (all Dimethoate products) per acre per year (e.g. 1 pint of Dimethoate 400).
- Do not reapply Dimethoate 400 for 7 days.
- Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.
- Do not feed or graze livestock on treated plants.
- Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.
- This product is highly toxic to bees and other pollinators exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees or other pollinating insects are foraging in the treatment area.
